After the signature on the 12th of September 2013 of the *Agreement for the* assistance granted under the *Project Preparation Facility for the projects "Sustainable regional market-Bazaar Suceava", "Modern and efficient public lighting management in Suceava Municipality", "Electromobility-electric vehicles for a green municipality" submitted for funding within Objective 1 of the Thematic Focus Area 4 – "Improvement of the Environment" included in the Swiss-Romanian Cooperation Programme to reduce economic and social disparities within the enlarged European Union was signed, between The Ministry of Public Finance, as the National Coordination Unit and Suceava Municipality as Beneficiary, Suceava Municipality carried on the following actions with the purpose of completing the Support Measure:*

According to the procedures of public procurement of consultancy services, contracts between Suceava Municipality and SC Relians Corp SRL were signed, with the purpose of elaborating the Final Project Proposals and the Feasibility Studies for the three projects, and also the contract signed with Agentia de Audit Financiar AFIL SRL for the external financial audit for the activities, accounts and records made within the support measure.

The assistance provided through the Project Preparation Facility Agreement amounts to 105.885 Swiss francs, which is the equivalent of 381.080,12 Lei.

The total funding allocated to Objective 1 of the Thematic concentration Area 4 "Improving of the Environment" included in the Swiss-Romanian Cooperation Programme amounts to a maximum of 37 million CHF .
